### **DISTRICT 128, POLICE AND VILLAGE JOIN FORCES TO MAINTAIN SAFE STREETS DURING FOOTBALL SEASON**

**Libertyville, Ill.** — High school football season is right around the corner. The Wildcats of Libertyville High School will take the field for their home opener on Friday, Sept. 5 against McHenry High School. Community High School District 128 has worked closely with the Village of Libertyville and the Libertyville Police Department to ensure that residents who live adjacent to the football field feel as undisturbed as possible during the home games. While parking is always at a premium during LHS events, it will be even more so this year while the school undergoes construction. To make sure that game days run smoothly for residents as well as game attendees, District 128 would like to stress parking restrictions that will continue to be enforced during LHS football games.

Last year, the Village of Libertyville installed permanent “NO PARKING” signs in the Heritage neighborhood east of LHS. People who park on the neighborhood streets will receive tickets. Should parking not be available when arriving at LHS, fans are asked to park at the Brainerd building, located east of the school at the corner of Park Ave. and Brainerd. Shuttle service will also be available for fans parking at the Libertyville train station.
